CHESS ATHLETICS TRAINING

The Camp aims to combine practical experience with educational values, in sports and naturalistic contexts, without ignoring serious chess training, and to provide an opportunity for those who wish to improve their technical skills with a view to athletics events.

The training offered by our instructors, all qualified **FSI Masters and Instructors**, is intended for young chess players who have previous experience in athletics and wish to continue their technical training with specific preparation that will enable them to give of their best in tournaments such as the Finale of the **Italian Youth Championship (CIG)**.
